



Westfield Country Club Golf Course Master Plan

Greetings All!

In 2016, Westfield Country Club and Hurdzan Golf Design launched a three-year phased project to resolve issues and enhance opportunities as part of a long-range golf course master plan. Below is information related to the status of the project.

South Course (Phase 2) – the landscape is a traditional Parkland style golf course; green, lush and well-manicured playing conditions. Construction is concluding and will be ready to open at some point in the spring of 2019. The opening date is dependent on how the course overwinters and will be determined next spring through a set of measurable criteria. The criteria ensure course standards are matched at the onset of opening and preserves the long-term health and viability of the playing surfaces.

North Course (Phase 3) – Links style landscape presented with an open, rustic, natural look requiring fewer inputs such as water, fertilizer and other plant health care products. Construction on the North Course started last week and will be executed through 2019, with the opening anticipated in the summer of 2020. The primary component of the North Course renovation is tree removal, which commenced late this week and will become an obvious sign of the initiation of Phase 3.

Additionally, with both the South and North Courses now considered construction sites; for the safety and welfare of all parties, access to both courses is limited to authorized personnel only. Activities such as walking, jogging, sled riding, cross country skiing, fishing and the use of ATV's are strictly prohibited.
