

VILLAGE OF WESTFIELD CENTER, OHIO

RESOLUTION 2023-02

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE INTENT OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTFIELD CENTER IN 2023 TO SELL BY INTERNET AUCTION PERSONAL PROPERTY, INCLUDING MOTOR VEHICLES AND OTHER PROPERTY REFERENCED IN REVISED CODE §721.15 WHICH ARE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE OR ARE OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR THE USE FOR WHICH THEY WERE ACQUIRED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Revised Code §721.15 authorizes this Council to adopt a resolution to authorize the sale by internet auction of personal property owned by the Village, including motor vehicles, and other personal property equipment referenced in Revised Code §721.15 which are no longer needed for public use or obsolete or unfit for the use for which they were acquired; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to adopt such a Resolution expressing its intent to sell the property by internet auction during the year 2023; and

WHEREAS, this Council authorized the Mayor or his designee to enter into an agreement with an internet auction site to conduct such internet auction services; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to authorize the Fiscal Officer to advertise in a newspaper of general circulation a notice of intent to sell unneeded, obsolete or unfit municipal personal property by internet auction; and

WHEREAS, this Council further wishes to authorize the Fiscal Officer to post notice of the intent to sell unneeded, obsolete or unfit municipal personal property on the Village website throughout the year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Westfield Center, Medina County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: This Council adopts this Resolution for the purpose of expressing its intent to sell unneeded, obsolete or unfit personal property by internet auction. The number of days for bidding on the property shall be no less than fifteen (15) days.

Section 2: Pursuant to Revised Code §721.15, the Fiscal Officer is authorized and directed to publish notice of this Resolution in a newspaper of general circulation.

Section 3: This Council further authorizes and directs the Fiscal Officer to publish a notice of this Resolution on the Village's website during the year 2023.

Section 4: That the Village Council, by at least three-fourths vote of all its members, does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on three separate days, pursuant to Section 731.17(A)(2) of the Ohio Revised Code, and authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 5: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to allow for the sale of unneeded Village owned equipment at the earliest possible time.
