## ORDINANCE 2023-04

## AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE DISPOSAL OF MUNICIPAL PERSONAL PROPERTY

**WHEREAS**, the Village Police Department has in its possession the following items of personal property (hereafter collectively the "Obsolete Property") that is not needed for public use:

- a) Two black office chairs on rollers, torn and worn cover
- b) Two rear seats for possible Dodge Charger
- c) One metal center console rusted
- d) One metal center front and rear seat divider rusted
- e) One Cruiser dash camera outdated
- f) Two Scanners
- g) Two Kenwood Police radios
- h) One outdated uniform
- i) One outdated gun belt

WHEREAS, the Obsolete Property is unfit for the use for which it was acquired and has no value;

**WHEREAS**, the Village wishes to dispose of the Obsolete Property pursuant to the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Westfield Center that:

- 1. The Police Chief, or his designee, is authorized to dispose of the Obsolete Property by discarding or salvaging it and shall take such other or further steps as are necessary to remove the Obsolete Property from any inventory lists maintained by the Police Department or the Village.
- 2. An emergency is hereby declared due to the immediate need to dispose of obsolete property for the health, safety and welfare of the Village employees and its residents.
